## About the project



We're planning to regenerate 33-47 Mill Lane flats, boarding garage sites and Abacus, to create 29 much-needed affordable homes within the Sevenoaks community.

We're working closely with the community to make sure our proposals reflect what matters most to you. This regeneration project is about creating high-quality, affordable homes and improving the area for everyone who lives here.

## Project timeline

If our proposals go ahead, we expect the build duration to be around two years from when we start. We are starting the process now to make sure the project is complete by spring 2029.

Some key dates we're aiming for:

- September 2025 – first public consultation and follow up
- November 2025 – second public consultation and follow up
- December 2025 – West Kent review of consultation and planning application
- December 25/ Jan 26 – planning application submitted
- June 2026 – approval or decline of planning permission
- January 2027 – start building new homes in the community (if approved).

We hope that these timescales are met but also know things can change along the way.
