Main purpose of the Role

Main duties

Depending on the number of applications, you should allow between 4 7 hours of reading per round of funding. You should consider your decisions prior to the meeting/s and highlight any areas for discussion.
- You should familiarise yourself with the Terms of Reference of the fund to ensure your decision making is in accordance with the guidelines.
- Your decision making should be impartial, and you will be expected to declare any interests at the start of the meeting/s.
